

91.25: Emil Mark/Lloyd Strange Fishing Hole



Scenic day use park, popular for fishing. Be respectful of others; pass to river right and avoid fishing lines. Steep bank with concrete stairs makes launch/takeout difficult. Good place to see agriculture operations.

91: Halls Ferry Landing



Small public access area at the site of the former Halls Ferry, established in the 1880s.

Three blocks up from the landing on Halls Ferry Road is the Port Manning House, built in 1884, and one of the best remaining examples of Italianato architecture.
