



**193.5-194: Log Jam Landing**



(OPRD)



This is a Greenway site that has relatively poor offerings. It is also quite noisy because of Jasper Road across the river. This site remains one of the few currently designated campsites on this stretch (no amenities).

**194.5: Log Jam Access**

This is a Greenway site that has a small backwater. On the bank are a few benches, although access is not the greatest.
