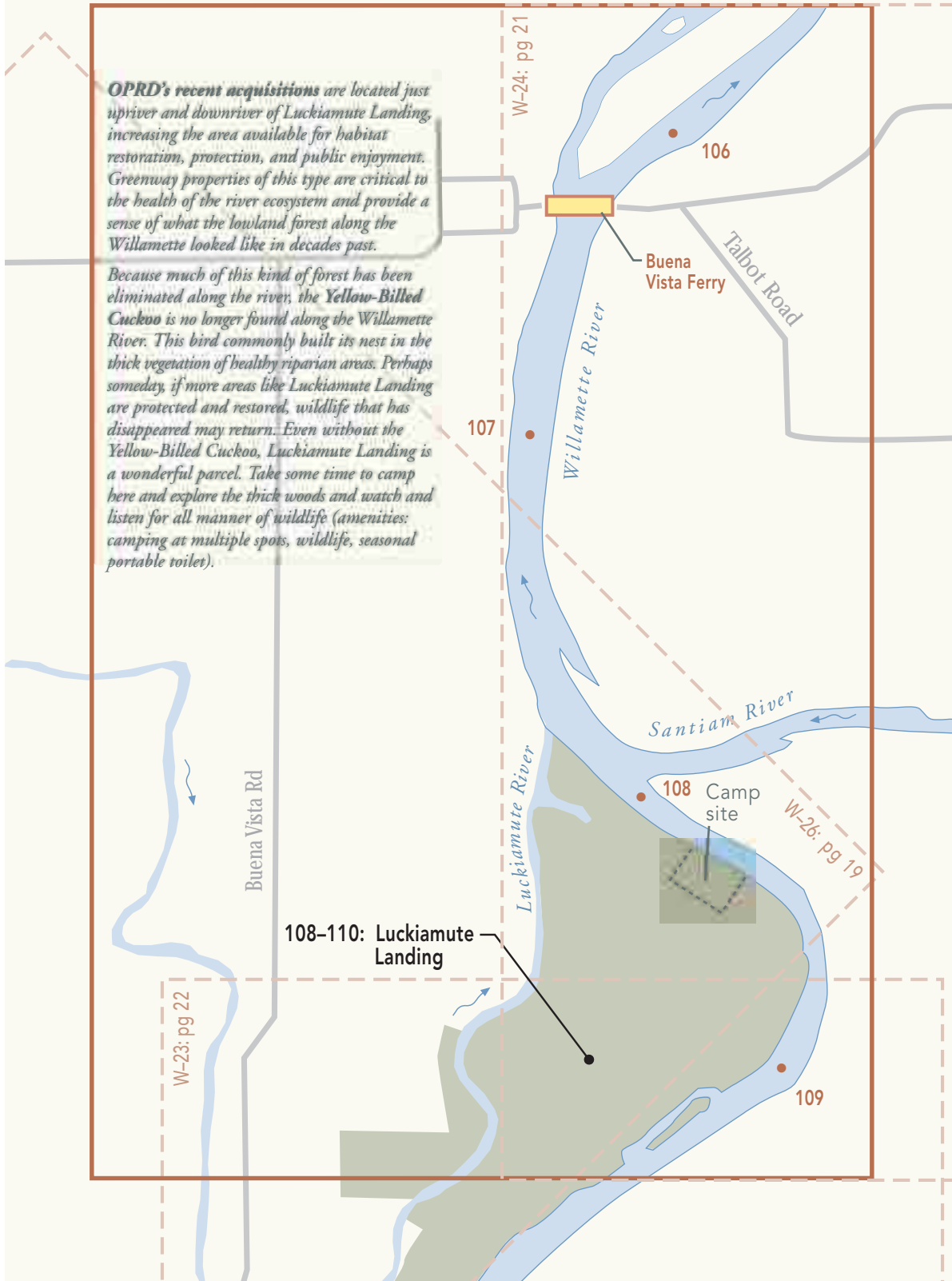


*OPRD's recent acquisitions are located just upriver and downriver of Luckiamute Landing, increasing the area available for habitat restoration, protection, and public enjoyment. Greenway properties of this type are critical to the health of the river ecosystem and provide a sense of what the lowland forest along the Willamette looked like in decades past.*

*Because much of this kind of forest has been eliminated along the river, the Yellow-Billed Cuckoo is no longer found along the Willamette River. This bird commonly built its nest in the thick vegetation of healthy riparian areas. Perhaps someday, if more areas like Luckiamute Landing are protected and restored, wildlife that has disappeared may return. Even without the Yellow-Billed Cuckoo, Luckiamute Landing is a wonderful parcel. Take some time to camp here and explore the thick woods and watch and listen for all manner of wildlife (amenities: camping at multiple spots, wildlife, seasonal portable toilet).*
